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CHCPRT001 IDENTIFY AND RESPOND TO CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE AT RISK

Child Protection Training

The *CHCPRT001 Identify and respond to children and young people at risk* (Child Protection) unit describes the skills and knowledge required to support and protect children and young people who are at risk of harm. This work occurs within legislative and policy frameworks and carries a duty of care responsibility. This unit applies to workers in a range of job roles providing services to children and young people including in community services and health contexts.

This training relates to the National Quality Standards (NQS) Quality Area 2 – Children’s health and safety.

Assessment is carried out in accordance with Commonwealth and State/Territory legislation, Australian/New Zealand standards and industry codes of practice.

- ✓ Report indications of possible risk of harm
- ✓ Apply ethical and nurturing practices in work with children and young people
